## **Animal Craft Stick Puzzle**


## **Materials**

- Tape


## **Instructions**


- Cut out puzzle section from outline and color

- 5. Using a craft knife or scissors, cut through picture to cut the sticks apart
















Found in the tropical rainforests of South America, the pygmy marmoset (Callithrix pygmaea) is the smallest monkey in the world at 13cm body length and a 20cm long tail!






Weighing over 7 lbs. and growing over a foot long, the **goliath frog** (Conraua goliath) is the largest frog in the world!









Flying over the open ocean for food, the wandering albatross
