## Answers:

1. A series of changes in stages in a plant/animal from birth to adulthood.
2. There are four stages in a butterfly's life cycle.
3. The stages for a butterfly are egg, larva (caterpillar), pupa (chrysalis), and adult.
4. There are four stages in a frog's life cycle.
5. The frog's life cycle are egg, tadpole, froglet, and adult.
6. <b>Larva</b> is the <b>caterpillar</b> stage of a butterfly.
7. <b>Pupa</b> is the <b>chrysalis</b> stage of a butterfly.
8. The froglet stage grows legs.
9. Butterflies and frogs are <b>adults</b> when they finish developing.
10. They both have an egg stage.

**Remember:** All organisms have birth, growth, reproduction, and death in common.
